There is a lot of development going in the Marshall community. Let's check in with EDA director, Lauren Deutz and get an update.

There have been many people wondering what the status of the old ShopKo building is. Harbor Freight has been in there for several months. What is the latest on Marshalls and is what is the status of Big Lots?

One of two of the building permits for Marshalls has been issued and crews are onsite to begin infrastructure and exterior work on the building. We do not have a timeline of when the project is expected to be completed. The Retail Center owner is no longer negotiating a lease with Big Lots and is actively pursuing a third tenant for the remaining 33,000 sq ft.

What is else is going on as far as development goes in Marshall such as the Solugen, the building between the DQ and Western Mental Health, the Mall, SW/WC, etc.?

There are several construction projects underway in Marshall including the SWWC Admin Office being built on London Road and Kwik Trip's 2nd store located on the corner of Main St and Hwy 59. Both projects started work in early June with Kwik Trip expected to be completed in November of 24 and SWWC to be completed in August of 25. The former Empire Office building located on E College Drive, which was formerly underutilized, is being torn down to create a future development site opportunity. The mall was previously purchased by Kal's Motor Group based out of Wadena to be used as a sales location for cars, motorsport vehicles, and equipment. The group intends to make updates to the mall as needed for future tenants. Solugen is the preconstruction phase and completing groundwork at the site to prepare for construction in early 2024.

There is an opening on the EDA Board. If someone were interested, how does one apply?

All City Board and Commission openings are posted on the City's website. You can also find the application form under the Administration page under "Boards and Commissions".

Childcare is an ongoing issue. What is being done locally?

The City has been accepted into the Child Care Strategic Supply Plan through First Children's Finance. This 8-month program will work with local stakeholders to educate on and determine local child care challenges. Goals will be established through the program to help address the community needs with the intent of increasing child care availability.


